Face Mask Guidelines

The CDC, CHFS, and Kentucky Public Health recommends wearing face masks when people go out in public. The Owen County School system supports this recommendation for the health, safety, and welfare of all persons on school grounds.

Anyone who enters a building owned by the Owen County School system, or uses district transportation, must wear a face mask. The mask must be worn appropriately at all times.



Face Mask Requirements

1. Fit snugly around both nose and mouth
2. Include multiple layers of fabric and allow for breathing without restriction
3. Be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape
4. No face shields unless worn in conjunction with a mask

According to school dress code, students may not wear clothing, masks, accessories, and/or jewelry that has any words or images that are crude, vulgar, obscene, libelous, slanderous or sexually suggestive. Clothing, accessories or jewelry that degrade any cultural, political, religious or ethnic values, that advocate racial, ethnic or religious prejudice, or that promote sex, the use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol or unlawful acts is prohibited. Clothing portraying the confederate flag is prohibited.
