<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All students will receive a computer device to complete classwork. • Students will be required to wear a mask per CDC and district guidelines when they cannot maintain social distancing. • Students will follow CDC guidelines on handwashing and appropriate safety guidelines at all times. • Students can enter the building at 7:20am. • Students will pick up a grab-and-go breakfast and go to their designated homeroom to eat each morning. • Students will remain in their homeroom throughout the day and teachers will rotate between classes. (Students will travel to Related Arts.) • Each grade level will have a designated lunch time. Students will be masked and walk through the lunch line single file. Cafeteria will provide grab-and-go lunches. Students will eat in the classroom or outside (social distancing will be followed). • IPE: Students will have IPE immediately after lunch and must mask if unable to social distance (following CDC suggestions). • Teachers will schedule frequent movement breaks every class period. • Each classroom teacher will have a Google Classroom setup for each class. • Dismissal will proceed as normal and students will wear masks while transitioning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will participate in a remote learning program from home using Google Classroom. • All students receive a computer device, and instructional materials to work at home. • Students have flexible instructional times. Lessons will be recorded so students can work at an individual pace. • Google Classroom will be the platform teachers will use for lessons and assignments. • Teachers will be available through office hours and virtual communication such as: virtual meetings, messaging, emails and phone calls. • Students will receive lessons, guidance, mentoring and assistance with setting goals as needed. • Students will adhere to the same Kentucky Academic Standards as traditional learners.
