- Students will be responsible to watch short videos of teachers teaching for all subjects.
- The level of expectation and accountability will resemble that of the traditional classroom. Our goal is to provide equitable educational opportunities to students at home and in school.
- Students will be responsible for all assignments and assessments that are being completed in school. They will need to turn these in digitally.
- Students will be expected to do a Google Meet with their teacher on an as needed basis.

Things to Remember:

- Students will receive instruction from their teacher virtually. Lessons will NOT be live. Teachers will pre-record lessons. There may be times when students will need to be available for a Google Meet with their teacher.
- Students will NOT be on the school campus.
- Families will sign up for Class Dojo.
- High-quality Internet access will be needed
- This is NOT NTI. The difference between NTI and Remote Learning is that NTI was all review work in paper packets. Remote Learning is on the computer and all new material. There will be other supplies like manipulatives and books that could come home to assist in the learning. Supplies will be based on your child's grade.
- Parents will need to be available to assist children when needed.
- Students will be enrolled in remote learning for an entire quarter (9 weeks).
- Teachers may not be available at the exact time a question may arise. They will get back to you as soon as they are able to. Please remember, they will have students in their classroom as well.
