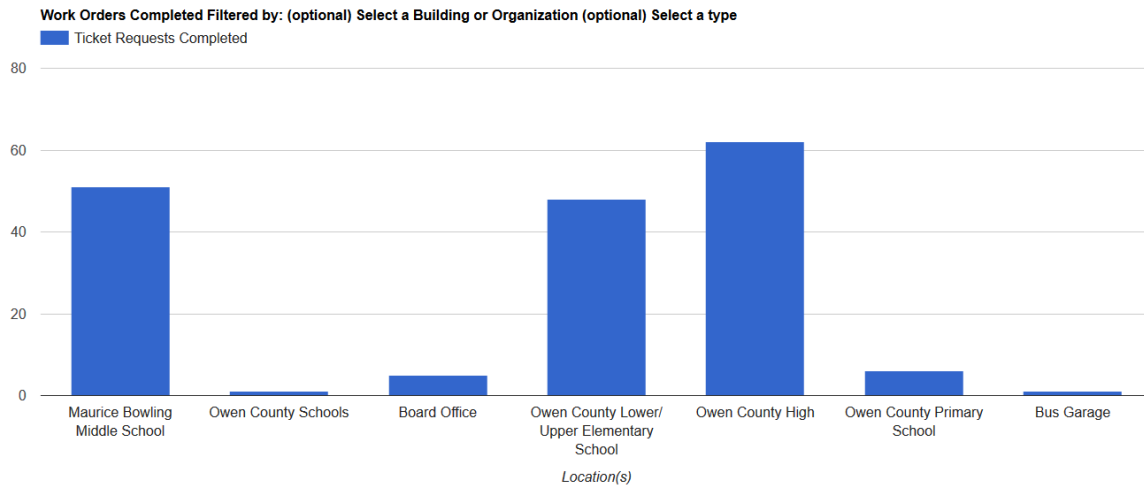




September 2017 Technology Report



Technology Department Projects and Events

- Six standard projectors and mounts have been ordered and will be installed at the lower.
